



Data Thistle Impact Feed Specification

v1.1

This document describes extra impact fields included on addition to default fields as described in a separate document **Data Thistle Default Feed Specification**

Event

Impact feeds contain the following additional fields:

ranking_level	number	required	1,2 or 3
ranking_in_level	number	required	1,2 or 3

A ranking level is a measure of the likely importance of an event both in terms of its national, regional or local significance, with the corresponding values 1,2 and 3.

The ranking in level has a further 3 values, and acts as a sub classification.

The two fields together give a total of nine possible combinations.

For example, these fields might be used as follows:

Place

Place has a properties field with an additional property:

place.capacity.max	string	Maximum capacity of venue
--------------------	--------	---------------------------

This property is an indication of the size of the venue in terms of the largest audience it can have at any one time. Of course, venues can have different configurations and most events will not sell out and have an audience that reaches this capacity.
